**Project Description**

Nike store is located in the Mediterranean Cosmos Mall, at the eastern part of Thessaloniki, near the airport. This mall is currently the biggest in North Greece, covering a surface of 250.000m<sup>2</sup>. It includes 220 stores, 37 restaurants and cafeterias in an area of about 46.000m<sup>2</sup>. Nike store covers an area of 236m<sup>2</sup>. In the past several different systems for the floor (PVC, wood, e.t.c.) have been used.

**Project Requirements**

The challenge for this application was multiple:

- To propose a system with an athletic outlook that fits with the Nike brand
- To finish and deliver the floor within 5 days
- To create a floor friendly to the customer, easy to maintain, easy to clean and strong enough to withstand a lot of pedestrian traffic and still look perfect

**Sika Solution**

The system that was chosen to fulfill all these requirements was **Sika® ComfortFloor®**, a permanently elastic PU system, solvent free, with very low VOC emissions, easy to maintain and with good mechanical resistance. The system build up contained application of **Sikafloor®-156** (epoxy primer), **Sikafloor®-330** (self levelling coat) and **Sikafloor®-305 W** as sealer, achieving a total thickness system of about 2mm. **Sikafloor®-305 W** Ral 9016 was used for all the linepaints. The epoxy system was combined with a wooden area in the middle.
