IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS

- Do not apply Sikafloor[®] MultiDur ES-18 on substrates with rising moisture.
- The incorrect assessment and treatment of cracks may lead to a reduced service life and reflective cracking.
- For exact colour matching, ensure the Sikafloor[®]-264 N in each area is applied from the same control batch numbers.
- After application, the products must be protected from damp, condensation and water for at least 24 hours.

• For roller / textured coatings: Uneven substrates as well as inclusions of dirt cannot and must not be covered by thin sealer coats. Therefore both substrate and adjacent areas must always be prepared and cleaned thoroughly prior to application.
