DESCRIPTION

SCHÖNOX® MULTIFIX is an acrylic adhesive and tackifier, suitable for "release" bond of textile floor coverings, CV coverings and SL tiles on all water-resistant substrates suited for this purpose in interior areas.

USES

SCHÖNOX® MULTIFIX is suitable for the fixation of:

- Textile coverings with
- foam backing, either smooth or embossed
- latex foam, latex coated or polyurethane foam backing
- synthetic secondary backing or jute backing
- suitable non-woven backing
- CV coverings
- SCHÖNOX TS
- SL tiles for anti-slip (pay attention to method of working)

on suitable substrates in interior areas.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

- Adequate strength, load bearing capacity, dimensional stability and permanent dryness.
- Free of residues which reduce adhesion, e.g. dust, dirt, oil, fat and loose particles.
- For fixing floor coverings:
 - The existing floor should be checked for firm attachment to substrate, moisture-proof, closed surface and cleanliness. Old floors should be cleaned thoroughly.
 - Complete removal of SCHÖNOX® MULTIFIX is not guaranteed from ceramic tiles, natural stone, parquet, linoleum and other open-pored coverings.
- In order to receive the substrate requirements of the specific coverings, refer to the technical product information of the coverings manufacturer.
- The requirements of the relevant valid standards, guidelines and data sheets apply.

MIXING

SCHÖNOX® MULTIFIX is a very low emission acrylic adhesive and tackifier and should be stirred before use.

APPLICATION METHOD / TOOLS

- Coverings to be laid with SCHÖNOX® MULTIFIX should be conditioned, unstressed and in a flat position.
- Spread the fixation evenly on the substrate. Avoid lumps of adhesive.
- The right amount of adhesive is determined by the backing of the covering. Ensure that there is adequate wetting.
- Recommended trowel size: TKB A1, A2, A3, A4 or

roller.

- SCHÖNOX® MULTIFIX can be mixed with up to 50 % water to reduce adhesion.
- Textile coverings with synthetic secondary backing are usually laid during the "semi-wet phase".
- Coverings with a smooth backing are usually laid during the "contact phase".
- Carpet tiles are fixed with diluted SCHÖNOX® MULTI-FIX to make them more easily removeable. They are laid during the "contact-phase".
- The level of dilution should be adjusted to the covering. The adhesion of the covering should be sufficient, but still possible to loop up.
- If in doubt, create a testing area or ask for special information.
- After laying without bubbles, rub down the covering and after a waiting time rub again or roll it.
- Laying stages:
 - "semi-wet phase": start of contact phase, adhesive groove domes are transparent, stringiness is present. Adhesive groove is not yet dried through.
- "contact phase": adhesive film is transparent, but still tacky.
- To take up the covering:
 - To remove, the covering is slowly peeled away from the substrate.
 - Remove adhesive residues with soapy water after soaking for approx. 30 minutes. This process can be repeated as needed.
- Direct securing to old adhesive residues can lead to interactions and thus to unpleasant smells.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT

Removal of fresh remnants from tools and application equipment can be carried out using water immediately after use. Hardened / cured material can only be mechanically removed.
